Ambitious targets in NL: Rapid increase of take back required



Improve Dutch legislation

- Define measurement point of **fiber-to-fiber recycling**
- More European circular economy by including products like curtains, carpets and ropes in definition of F2F recycling
- **Facilitate multiple PROs** per stream:
 - Reward best performing PROs
 - Guarantee collection for municipalities
 - Clear rules for producers switching PROs
- **Online marketplaces** and direct sellers
- Durability not yet rewarded
- Workwear and household textiles need special requirements and targets
- Best efforts requirements -> **clear norms**

Collection Improvements: Cooperation with municipalities



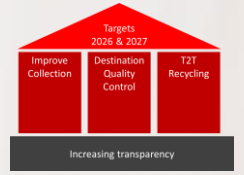
Collection method	Share

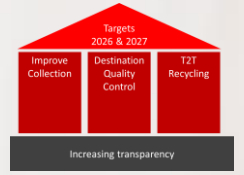


End unnecessary movement of textiles to Global South

- We aim to be not just compliance providers but a **strategic partner**, helping producers access recycled materials and build circular supply chains

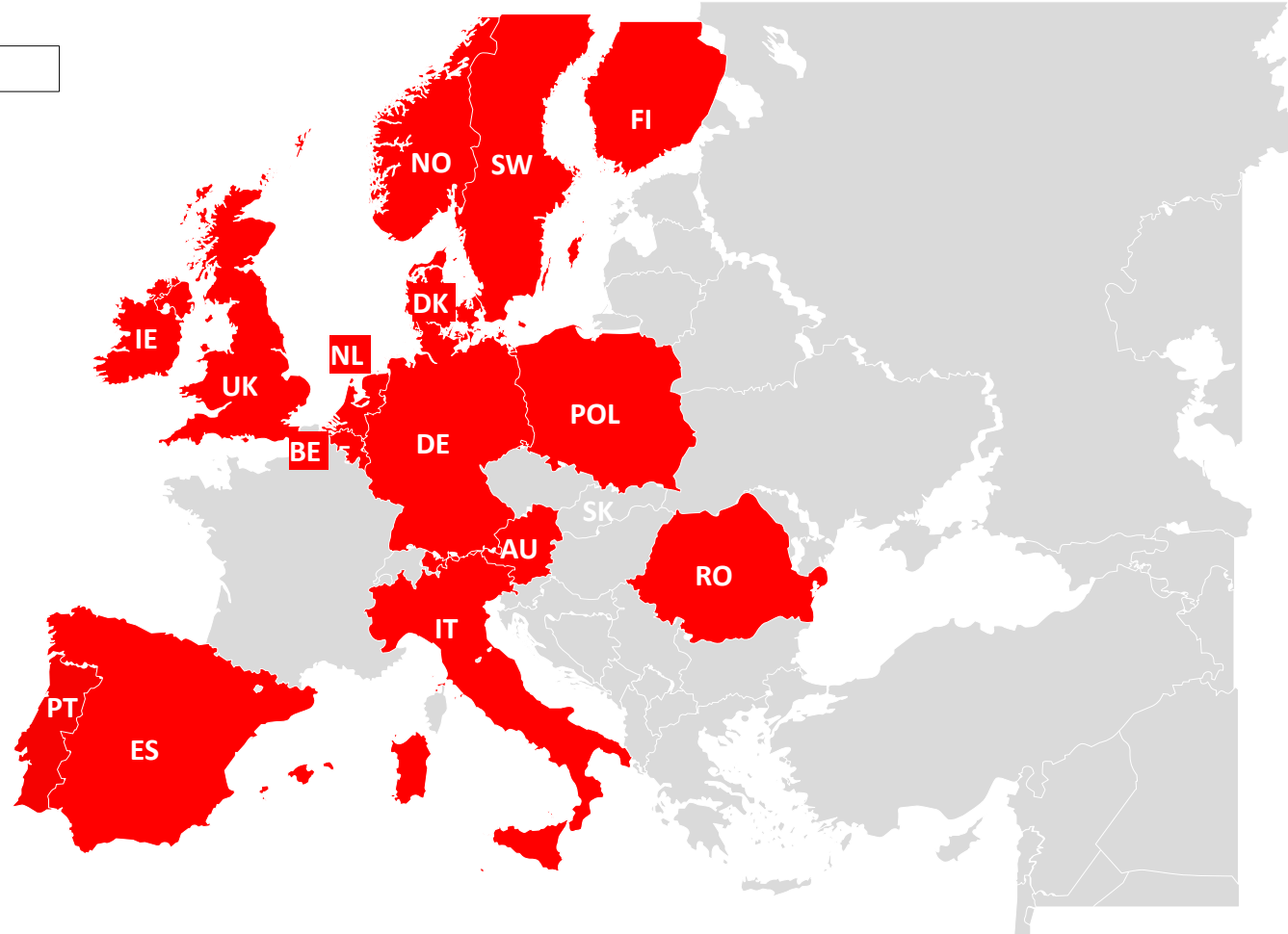
- We aim to support Producers in meeting **sustainability goals and strategies**
